LCFF funds include a base level of funding for all LEAs and extra funding - called "supplemental and concentration" grants - to LEAs based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learners, and low-income students).



his chart shows the total general purpose revenue Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria expects receive in the coming year from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria is \$2,918,390, of which \$2338745 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$252958 is other state funds, \$154718 is local funds, and \$171969 is federal funds. Of the \$2338745 in LCFF Funds, \$358251 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

The LCFF gives school districts more flexibility in deciding how to use state funds. In exchange, school districts must work with parents, educators, students, and the community to develop a Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) that shows how they will use these funds to serve students.



This chart provides a quick summary of how much Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria plans to spend for 2023-24. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.

The text description of the above chart is as follows: Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria plans to spend \$2501743 for the 2023-24 school year. Of that amount, \$1924280 is tied to actions/services in the LCAP and \$577,463 is not included in the LCAP. The budgeted expenditures that are not included in the LCAP will be used for the following:



Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in the LCAP for the 2023-24 School Year

In 2023-24, Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria is projecting it will receive \$358251 based on the enrollment of foster youth, English learner, and low-income students. Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria must describe how it intends to increase or improve services for high needs students in the LCAP. Olive Grove Charter School - Orcutt/Santa Maria plans to spend \$1211740 towards meeting this requirement, as described in the LCAP.
